We will continue to enhance our universal practices of positive behavioral support, while communicating with families about our SIP practices and curriculum.

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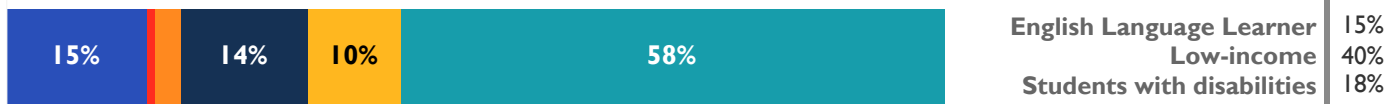

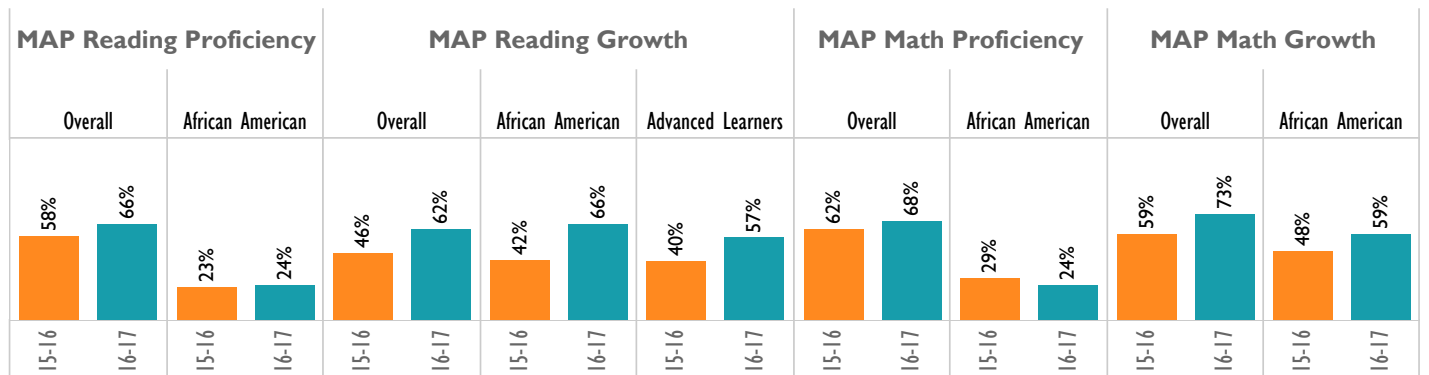

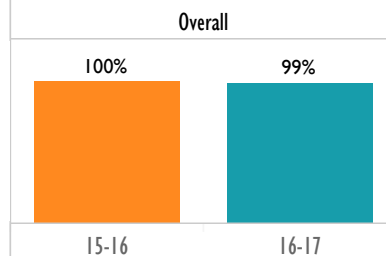
Strategic Framework Goal #1 Milestones: On-Track to Graduate
